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8. Report of FDP on "Qualitative Research Methods and Machine Learning" organized from $9^{\rm th}$ -14th July 2018

The term 'big data' always refer to quantitative data which can be easily expressed as numbers or categories. Statistical and machine learning techniques "love" numbers. On the other hand Qualitative researchers believe that numbers won't always work to draw inferences. They believe that by interviewing people and asking them to answer open-ended questions one can learn more than by simply looking at hard data. Moreover, data mining is the process of extracting hidden patterns from data. Data mining uses machine learning algorithms, to classify, predict, group, recommend, etc. So, the knowledge of qualitative research methods, case study and machine learning software operation would enhance the user skill which in turn can be used in class room teaching and academic research supervision, writing Ph.D and M.Phil dissertations. Keeping this in view, our institute organize a Faculty Development Program on "Qualitative Research Methods and Machine Learning" from 9th - 14th July, 2018.

The aim of one week FDP is to understand right approach towards research design, methods and understanding of research epistemologies driving qualitative research methods. India's geo-climatic conditions as well as its high degree of socio-economic vulnerability, makes it one of the most disaster-prone country in the world. A disaster is an extreme disruption of the functioning of a society that causes widespread human, material, or environmental losses that exceed the ability of the affected society to cope with its own resources.



The expert lecture series on Disaster Management was started by inaugural speech by Ms. Sheela Narang, Assistant Professor, MERI College. The speaker for the Expert Lecture Serieson Disaster Management was Mr. M.K. Chattopadhyay, District Officer, Fire Services. He discussed about meaning and aim of disaster management. Further he discussed about what disaster, effects, its types and how we can prevent the disaster. He spoke on Delhi Fire services and its

strengths, Delhi management center, he discussed about what is fire, stages of fire, fire triangle, extinguishment methods, classification of fire, problems in fire, killer gases, who provides heat, electrical short circuit, naked flames, hot surfaces, exothermic reaction, wiring at home, precautions in wiring, use correct wire, fire safety measures, fire extinguishers, doorways, hose reel, wet riser/ down comer, sprinkler system, automatic detection system, yard hydrants, manual operation water CO2, method of operation foam, method of operation carbon dioxide(CO2), method of operation of dry chemical powder(DCP).
